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## **\$218,203 Raised for Local Schools in Response to \$25,000 Match from Kilroy Realty**

*Funds raised will support arts classes, instructional aides and  
other staff and programs at Santa Monica public schools*

**Santa Monica, Calif., September 11, 2020** – Funding for Santa Monica public schools received a boost from 309 people who contributed during the Santa Monica Education Foundation's back-to-school match. The donors contributed \$218,203 in response to a \$25,000 match from Kilroy Realty, for a combined total of \$243,203 raised during a one-week donation drive, which ran from September 2 to 9.

The donations will fund staff and programs during the school day at all 12 public schools in Santa Monica. In the current distance-learning model, programs funded by donations are being delivered online. Arts programs will take place this fall online. Instructional aides funded by donations are helping students in online breakout rooms. Donations are also funding stretch grants at each school. Because each campus decides how to spend their stretch grant, these funds are a flexible source of income as each school responds to changing needs during distance learning.

"Thank you to each donor who has contributed this school year and to Kilroy Realty for their inspiring matching gift!" said Linda Greenberg, Executive Director of the Ed Foundation. "Unfortunately, our fundraising at the start of school this year is lower than it is in a typical year, as would be expected. However, the wonderful results of this match show our community's continued dedication to public education. Even during difficult times, our donors have come together to help ensure that Santa Monica students experience an enriched education. I encourage everyone who is able to donate to give. Our students very much need your support."
