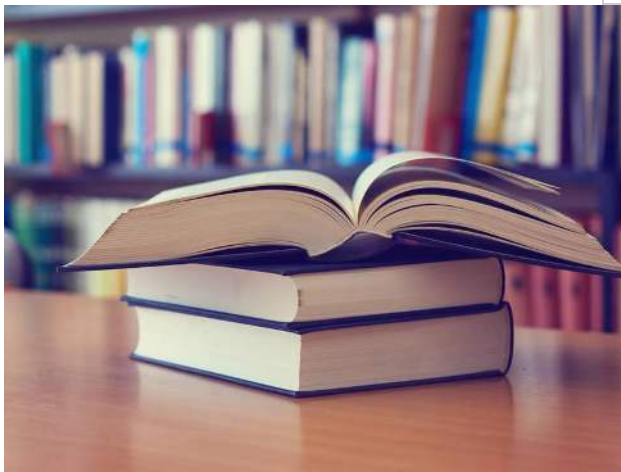


Education Foundation Raises \$184K For Santa Monica-Malibu Schools

SMMUSD saw donations surge thanks to a combined \$50,000 match from Fairmont Miramar Hotel & Bungalows/MSD Capital and CIT's OneWest Bank.

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MALIBU, CA – The Santa Monica-Malibu Education Foundation concluded their annual parent fundraising appeal with a surge in donations – 698 donors contributed \$184,709 for programs in SMMUSD schools during the match from Jan. 16-31. The donations were inspired by a \$50,000 match from Fairmont Miramar Hotel & Bungalows/MSD Capital and CIT's OneWest Bank, according to the SMMUSD press release. Each company offered \$25,000 and partnered to provide a \$50,000 match for the last two weeks of the Ed Foundation's parent campaign.

All funds donated to the Ed Foundation support staff and programs at all 16 Santa Monica-Malibu public schools, ensuring that SMMUSD students experience arts, STEM, wellness programs and other crucial elements of their education, the press release said.
