For every \$50 donated to SMMEF between March 9 and April 14, each donor was entered in a drawing to

win a Pedego Electric Bike, valued at more than \$2,700 (including tax).

A total of 166 people were entered into the bike drawing during the time period; \$55,215 was raised for SMMEF.
