

Dear Santa Monica-Malibu Education Foundation Supporter:

On September 20, 2012, the Education Foundation announced a \$4.8 million donation. This transformative gift, a bequest from the estate of the late Peggy Bergmann, is the largest of its kind to any education foundation in California. We are inspired by the brilliant opportunities this gift affords all of our District's students. (Read more about this amazing gift on page 3.)

This gift, along with a \$250,000 grant from the City of Santa Monica, set the Education Foundation on the path towards its new fundraising challenge – raising \$4 million annually for the Santa Monica-Malibu Unified School District (SMMUSD). To better reach this goal the Education Foundation hired a Director of Major Gifts and a Director of Annual and Leadership Gifts, increasing the organization's staff to five. This growth required us to move the Foundation into a larger office, and thanks to the generosity of in-kind donors, a gorgeous new office was re-constructed for us right next door to our old one!


While the Education Foundation shifted its focus to a major fundraising campaign, the Superintendent's Advisory Committee (SAC) continued its work to develop a plan benefiting all students in SMMUSD. This committee, made up of PTA leaders, Principals, parents, SMMEF staff, and union leaders, met monthly to formulate a District-wide program affecting every student's educational experience. The SMMUSD Vision for Student Success, created by this committee, guarantees student enrichment and equity of programming across the District starting in 2014-15. The Vision for Student Success was designed to provide all Santa Monica and Malibu students with an inspiring, rich learning environment, and to ensure teachers have the support and ongoing education they need to help all students reach their full potential.

We are excited about this new direction for the Education Foundation, the District and most importantly, our students! While 2012-13 set us on a successful path towards providing exceptional education opportunities, your investment in our students and our schools is critical and impactful.

A Transformative Gift

Bequest from the Estate of the Late Peggy Bergmann

Peggy Bergmann had a passion for arts and education. She also wanted to honor her parents and their love of music by providing music enrichment to socio-economically disadvantaged students throughout the District. Ms. Bergmann was motivated to donate to the Education Foundation by the District's move to a centralized fundraising effort and she hoped her gift would inspire others to give, no matter the size of their donations.

Her \$4.8 million bequest was divided into two parts: \$2.4 million was designated to establish an arts endowment to provide semi-private music instruction, as well as new musical instruments and their maintenance, for socio-economically disadvantaged students. This newly-created endowment is known as the Peggy Bergmann Arts Endowment Fund, in

memory of Lenore Bergmann and John Elmer Bergmann. The additional \$2.4 million was unrestricted funding to support our organization and help address the District's most critical needs.

This extraordinary gift was the result of relationships and connections between Ms. Bergmann and long-time supporters of the Education Foundation, and from Ms. Bergmann's desire to improve education for ALL students in our School District. She believed that we, as a community, must support all our students to make our community stronger and more vibrant.

We will be forever grateful to Ms. Bergmann for believing in our District, our Education Foundation and our students.



The Santa Monica-Malibu Education Foundation Defined

We are committed to educational excellence for every child in our public schools.

Established in 1982 in response to devastating Federal and State education budget cuts, the Santa Monica-Malibu Education Foundation was organized by a dedicated group of parents, community leaders, and local businesses to enhance and supplement the curriculum of the Santa Monica-Malibu Unified School District.

Since its inception, the Education Foundation has helped bridge the gap between what our schools need and what the State provides. In this era of cuts to State funding for public education, contributions make a tremendous difference

in the District's ability to continue to provide the quality educational resources that every student deserves.

Since 2012-2013, the Education Foundation has been leading the major annual fundraising effort to support the SMMUSD Vision for Student Success, to be implemented in 2014-2015. This \$4 million annual campaign is supported by contributions through the Education Foundation from parents, teachers, staff, PTAs, businesses and the community. It will enable SMMUSD to provide schools with programs and resources that are necessary to ensure the success of every child in our District.

Education Foundation Programs in 2012-2013

Academics



Grants to Libraries, providing a total of \$50,384 to support all school libraries.*

Academic Enrichment Grants (AEGs), granting funds to District teachers to encourage classroom innovation. SMMEF awarded 30 AEGs up to \$1,000 each and 1 Super Grant for \$5,000 in 2012-13.

Tech4Success, providing technology training workshops and laptop computers to AVID (Advancement via Individual Determination) high school seniors who are the first generation in their families to attend college. Tech4Success awarded 4 laptops to graduating students in June 2013.

Athletics

Santa Monica 5000, a 5k/10k run/walk that raises money for athletic programs in our schools. An incredible community event that drew over 1,300 participants from our school community and collectively raised \$84,574 in its second year in October 2012.



Summer



Summer Adventure, co-sponsored with the Santa Monica-Malibu Council of PTAs, offering a summer enrichment program to nearly 800 students in elementary and middle schools in Santa Monica and Malibu.

Ed Ahead, a fee-based, for-credit high school summer program where students complete a one-year curriculum for a single subject in six weeks at Malibu and Santa Monica High Schools. 295 students participated in Ed Ahead in 2012.

More Education Foundation Programs in 2012-2013

Arts



Third Grade Recorders, providing instruments and instruction for all 827 third-graders for use in their General Music classes.*

Dream Winds Elementary, providing more than 280 hours of semi-private music lessons in wind instruments to students at the District's four Title 1 elementary schools.

Dream Winds and Dream Strings, providing more than 480 hours of semi-private music lessons in wind and string instruments to students at the District's two Title 1 feeder middle schools.

Middle School Drama Program, a partnership with PTAs, providing after-school drama programs to over 130 students from John Adams, Lincoln and SMASH Middle Schools. 2012-2013 productions were "Seussical" (JAMS & SMASH) and "The Wizard of Oz" (Lincoln).*



High School Theater, funding new theater equipment and technical specialists to over 300 students for 7 productions at all three high schools and Malibu Middle School.*

Dance Classes, funding a dance specialist to work with over 500 students in Santa Monica and Malibu middle schools, Malibu High and Olympic High.*



Guitar and Music Performance Classes, the only music classes offered to student musicians at Olympic High School with 10 hours of instruction per week.*

Visual Arts Grants, providing equipment, materials and supplies for all secondary Visual Arts teachers.*

For The Arts Concert, an evening of music and philanthropy that joins student musicians from all three high schools with renowned artists for a concert to support the arts in our schools. 2013 was the 10th anniversary of this concert; over 10 years, these concerts have raised over \$800,000.

Your Money at Work

A Student's Story

Franklin Stevenson, Olympic High School Class of 2012

Franklin Stevenson loves music. When he arrived at Olympic High School as a sophomore, he knew he'd found a home in his Music classes. "This school is like a family, and Mark's classes were a safe place for me to come and play my music."

Since 2004, the Education Foundation has funded the only Music classes at Olympic: Guitar and Music Performance. Mark Harris has taught both classes since their inception. "These classes are an incentive for students to come to school," says Mark. "Many of these students don't see any other reason to show up." In fact, these classes were the reason Franklin stayed at Olympic. By the time he graduated in June 2012, he had excelled in school and was even selected to give the student speech at graduation.

Now, in addition to his job at Santa Monica's Fairmont Miramar Hotel, Franklin spends two hours a day assisting Mark in Olympic's Music classes, helping other students. "I love the classes; that's why I'm still here."

As he recounts his experiences with music during high school, Franklin says he'll never forget performing a guitar solo on stage with Jackson Browne at the Education Foundation's For The Arts Benefit Concert in April 2012. "That was something I'll never forget. It really was something special."

"Music will always be a part of my life," says Franklin. "I'm so lucky that I was given a chance to pursue it at school."



Our Endowments

Endowments provide a legacy of support for key programs at schools.

Thanks to generous donors, whose funding provides ongoing income, the Education Foundation has four major endowments:

- The For Academics Endowment, established in 1998, was valued at \$1,457,468 as of June 30, 2013 and provided almost \$50,000 for library support.
- The For The Arts Endowment, created in 2003, was valued at \$2,443,471 as of June 30, 2013. \$95,000 was used to fund arts programs.
- The Peggy Bergmann Arts Endowment Fund, in memory of Lenore Bergmann and John Elmer Bergmann, was created in February 2013 and was valued at \$2,483,182 as of June 30, 2013.
- The Education Foundation continues to build its For Athletics Endowment.

Our endowments provide a reliable source of funding, year after year, ensuring consistent programming District-wide. Growth of the endowments through charitable giving and investment gains enables the Education Foundation to provide students with an outstanding curriculum.
